At the June 19th Board Meeting, the Board approved the following:

- ◆ Kelly Plastering to replace damaged dryvit on Clubhouse exterior walls.



POOL RULE REMINDERS

- ◆ All guests must be accompanied by a resident.
- ◆ No strollers are allowed in the Pool Area.
- ◆ Radios or other open speaker electroic equipment are prohibited in the Pool Area or the Patio Area.
- ◆ Children not toilet trained are permitted in the wading pool only.
- ◆ Food is allowed in the Patio Area only.
- ◆ Only drinking water in a plastic container is allowed in the Pool Area.
- ◆ All assessments must be current before using Clubhouse facilities.
- ◆ Please note that children under 18 years cannot use the indoor pool unless they are accompanied by an adult. Also, children under 5 years are not allowed in the spa.

GUEST CARD RULES

The current By-Laws allow residents to “borrow” up to 6 Guest Passes from other residents for their use. The Board approved the availability of up to 12 total Guest Passes that can be issued daily by the Clubhouse attendant instead of “borrowed” passes. These Club Guest Passes will be issued on a first-come first-serve basis and are valid for only the day of issue. A resident may use his/her 2 Guest Passes and up to 6 Club Guest Passes to bring in a total of up to 8 guests. “Borrowed” passes may not be used at the same time as the Club Guest Passes. A log of passes will be kept.

BE KIND TO YOUR TREES!

Your trees need a good soaking to help them weather the stress of heat and bugs. The best way to water the trees is to soak the base until there is run-off. Also, if you live near a cul de sac, please consider watering the plants there.

The emerald ash borer is extremely active. Check your ash trees for top damage and trunk sprouts. And have any infected trees removed as soon as possible. Prevention may be possible using insecticide regimens. Contact a lawn control company for further details.

REMINDERS - make sure you maintain the ambiance of our Association. All trash cans must be stored in the garage and items such as ladders, construction and lawn materials, cannot be visible from the street. Please pick up all newspapers on your driveway.

Please pick up after your dog and please do not throw dog waste bags in other Resident's yards!!!

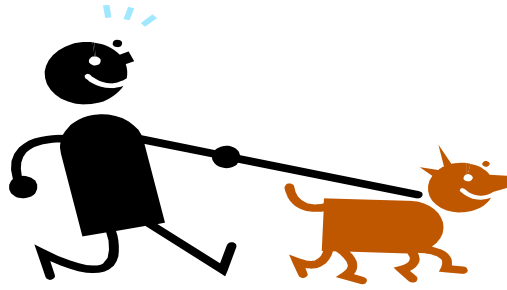

Bloomfield Club Association Dog Parade Waiver for July 27, 2013

The dog walker must be 18 years or older.

Your dog must:

- Wear a current rabies tag or license, or have proof of rabies vaccinations.
You will not be allowed to participate without this, so please come prepared
- Have current vaccinations.
- Be on a leash for the duration of the event.
- No retractable leashes or leashes over six feet, please.
- NOT be aggressive to people or other dogs.
- NOT be a female in heat.

Please Remember:

- Be courteous, responsible and scoop up after your pet. Poop bags are available.
- Use good judgment regarding the temperament of your dog so the event will be safe and enjoyable for everyone.
- Know your limitations and walk the course with your dog *only if the both of you are conditioned for it*. Water stations will be available throughout the venue.

WAIVER:

I understand that participating in the Bloomfield Club Association Dog Parade includes an element of risk for both me and my dog. I should not participate unless my dog and I are physically able and properly conditioned. I agree to abide by any decision of an event official relevant to the dog's and my ability to complete this event safely, and I further agree that event officials may authorize necessary emergency treatment for me and/or my dog. I also understand that both vehicle traffic and spectators may be present at the event and I assume the risk of participating under such conditions. I further assume any and all other risks associated with participating in this event, including, but not limited to, illness, falls, contact with spectators, other participants or dogs, the effects of the weather, including extreme temperature and humidity, and the surface condition of the roads, sidewalks, and footpaths, all such risks being understood and appreciated by me. I also affirm that the dog I will be participating with has current rabies vaccinations. I agree to abide by all rules of the event.

Having read this waiver and knowing these facts, and in consideration of this acceptance of this entry, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators or anyone else who might claim on my behalf, covenant not to sue, and waive, release and discharge the Bloomfield Club Association, event officials, volunteers, and any other sponsors, suppliers, agents, independent contractors, employees and other personnel in any way assisting or connected with this event from any claims or liability of any kind whatsoever arising out of my participating in this event, even though the liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or parties named in this waiver.

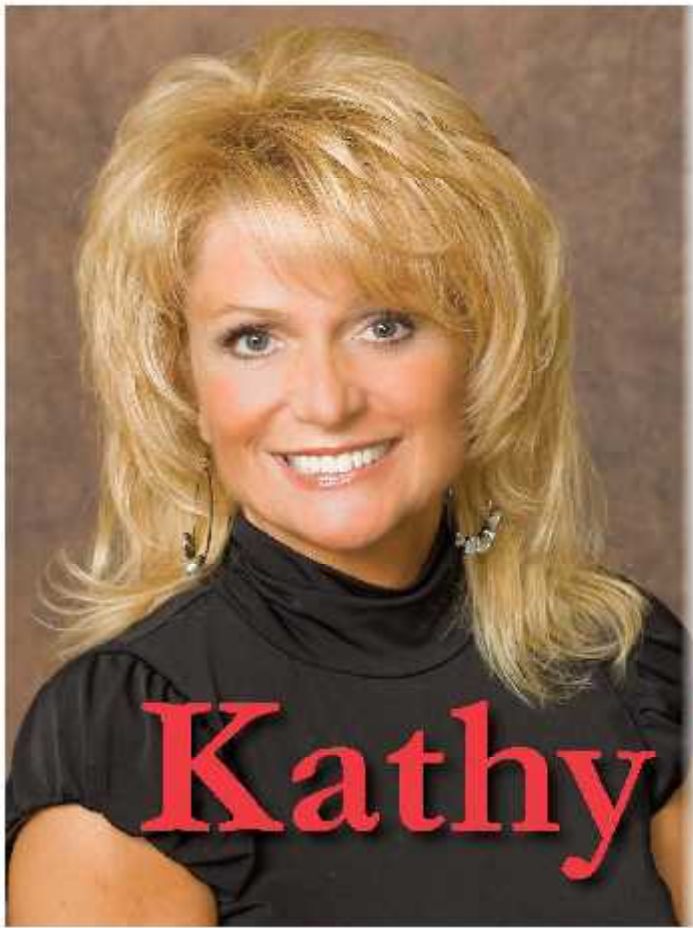
