At the April 15th Board Meeting, the Board approved the following:

- ◆ TruGreen to treat crabapple trees with three applications of apple scab treatment
- ◆ TruGreen to apply disease suppression for the Japanese Beetles that attack the roses.
- ◆ TruGreen to apply grub control on common areas.
- ◆ Green Horizon to install various flowers at the front entry & in front of the Clubhouse.
- ◆ Green Horizon to spread 100 cubic yards of mulch, which will be donated by the Village.
- ◆ To plant eight Boxwood bushes to replace dead bushes on Schick Road.
- ◆ Simply Transparent to clean all of the windows, inside & out.
- ◆ Mister Natural to clean all of the carpets.

## **Some of the basic pool rules:**

- ♦ Everyone who uses the pool must have a picture ID Card (Resident or Guest) that will be collected, swiped in the card reader for validation and filed by the attendant or lifeguard.
- The attendant or lifeguard will then give adult residents a blue plastic wrist bracelet; a green bracelet for resident children 17 years through 14 years; a red bracelet for resident children 13 years and younger and guests will receive a orange bracelet.
- All guests must be accompanied by a resident.
- Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied at all times by an adult, at least 18 years of age, who can be a guest.
- Resident children 14 years of age or older may use the outdoor pool without adult supervision and may bring guests 14 years of age or older.
- Children not toilet trained are allowed in the wading pool ONLY and must have rubber/plastic pants over the diaper. Swimwear is also required.
- All assessments must be current before using Clubhouse facilities. If an account is not current, the ID card will not allow access to the Clubhouse or the Pool Area.
