- 5) Chili should arrive hot and in your crock pot / slow cooker.
- 6) Bring your crockpot to the clubhouse party room at 11:30 and check-in with attendant.
- 7) You are responsible for cleanup of your personal items.
- 8) Please bring utensil / ladle and extension cord or power strip (if available).
- 9) Tasting and voting for best chili will take place during the 1st two quarters of the game.
- 10) Prize will be awarded to the chili with the most votes at halftime.
