COMMUNITY UPDATES

- A reminder that all homeowners must get a permit from the Village of Bloomingdale BEFORE starting any remodeling work. This includes, but it is not limited to mechanicals, electric or plumbing. Failure to obtain a permit can result in fines by the Village. If unsure if a permit is needed, please contact the Village.
- Help keep our neighborhood beautiful!! Water hoses should always be neatly stored. It's best to bring them inside in the winter to avoid freeze damage. All lawn care materials, such as bags of topsoil and fertilizer, as well as lawn tools should also be stored out of site.
